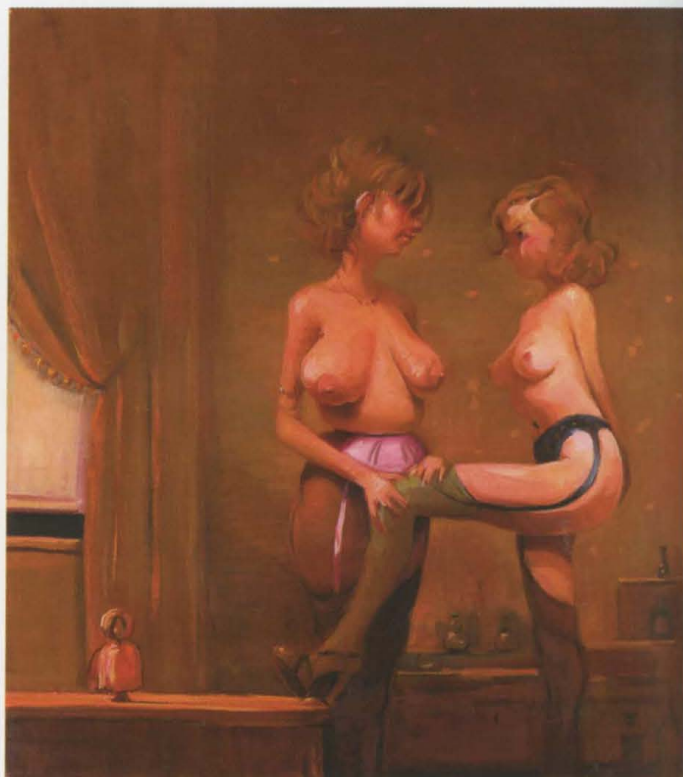

Northview is one of five or six large canvases that I made from 1999-2001. I titled them all simply *Northview*. The title reflects the name of an estate in Westchester, New York. I had been researching how photographs in *Penthouse* from the 1970s were made and I sent a fan letter to one of my favorite photographers among them (Bob Guccione having already passed away).

The photographer wrote back and I ended up in a long conversation with him about the way they worked and how their sets were borrowed mansions and beach houses. I had created a few paintings using borrowed images from *Penthouse* and felt uncomfortable continuing on that trajectory. Simultaneously, I was already beginning to work on paintings (1997/1998) derived from simple sets in my studio with handmade costumes, props, and furniture. This idea of borrowing a location stayed in my mind and shortly thereafter I was able to visit *Northview* with a friend whose mom lives there. I had also been reading about and was interested in the home of Laura Ashley. Her taste level and style were intriguing to me: über potent femininity. I brought models to *Northview* and made some pictures that I could take back to the studio to work from. This also marked a break in my work from the usual figure/ground relationship and got me more into the feeling of the ground being laced with the same intense feeling as the figure.
