The FLAG Art Foundation is pleased to present the two-part group exhibition *In New York, Thinking of You,* featuring largely new or never-before-exhibited artworks by over thirty female, female-identifying, and nonbinary artists, on view April 1-June 3, 2023, on the 10th floor. Centering on painting, *In New York, Thinking of You* highlights a range of formal disciplines, conceptual practices, subject matters, and approaches to art making. Taking inspiration and its title from the song, *hornylovesickmess*, 2022, by Norwegian singer-songwriter Marie Ulven aka girl in red, the exhibition features work either selected by the artists or made specifically for the exhibition that respond to the often-conflicting emotions and experiences laid bare in the song: desire, listlessness, longing, quiet reflection, romance, sex, tenderness, vulnerability, etc.
